

## KEY DOCUMENTS

Gathering the relevant documents ahead of time will make it easier for an attorney to evaluate whether you have grounds to challenge a deportation. Remember to go to an attorney specializing in deportation.

### FROM ANY CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

- Indictment
- Court minutes (especially plea allocution)
- Certificate of Criminal Disposition
- Defense Attorney(s) contact info & retainer agreement(s)
- "Snitch" agreement
- Immigration interview paperwork copy (if any)

### FROM ANY DEPORTATION PROCEEDING

- Notice To Appear (NTA) or Order to Show Cause (OSC)
- Immigration Judge Decision
- Board of Immigration Appeals (BIA) Decision
- Federal court decision(s)
- All briefs submitted to immigration and federal courts
- Immigration lawyer(s) contact info & retainer agreement(s)

### DETAINEES/DETENTION ISSUES

- Deport Officer contact info
- G-28 (Notice of Entry of Appearance)
- Order of supervision
- Complaints filed
- Notice of reinstatement of deportation order (absconders, re-entrants)

### POST-DEPORTATION

- Warrant/Notice of Deportation (listing bars, etc)
- All of the above
