PROTECT YOURSELF AND OTHERS:



SAFETY FIRST! If you feel unsafe, walk away.



RESPOND! If you feel safe, respond calmly and firmly to let them know that their actions are unwelcome.



DOCUMENT! Capture all the details about what happened, including the date, time, location, and contact information for any witnesses.



REPORT! Tell the proper authorities. Call 911 if you feel you are in danger.
