

# Temporary Protected Status (TPS) for Haiti

## What is TPS for Haiti?

TPS is a temporary immigration status that gives some Haitians protection from deportation and the ability to get a work permit. You can only receive TPS for up to 18 months at a time.

## Who can get TPS?

Right now, only Haitians who have been living in the United States since at least November 6, 2022 are eligible for TPS. Haitians who came to the United States after this date are not currently able to get TPS.

## My TPS is expiring soon. Can I renew it?

TPS for Haiti right now has only been granted until August 3, 2024. That means that if you have TPS right now and you have a work permit through TPS, it will expire on August 3, 2024. We likely will not know until June or July, or even the beginning of August, whether TPS for Haiti will be renewed. Until an announcement is made about an extension, there is no way to renew TPS or renew TPS work permits.

**If your TPS expires on August 3, 2024, right now it is not possible to request a renewal.**

**Do not give money to anyone who promises to renew your TPS!**

## How can I find out if TPS is renewed?
